

## J. Kenneth Tate

J. Kenneth (Kenny) Tate has started a number of private companies in South Florida over the past 30 years. With his brother Jimmy, Mr. Tate was a co-founder in the Tate Development Corporation, a developer/builder of custom and production single-family homes plus various types of commercial properties. Kenny has had a certified general contracting license in the State of Florida for over 25 years and was appointed by the Governor to serve on the State of Florida Contractors Licensing Board for seven of those years. During the late 1980's and early 1990's Mr. Tate was directly involved in the management and distressed real estate work out efforts for multiple State Court Receiverships in Dade and Broward County (details on attached rider). Additionally, during the time period between 1993 through 1996 Mr. Tate's construction and development company (Tate Development Corp.) managed the reconstruction efforts for approximately 2,000 multifamily and single family residences which were destroyed by Hurricane Andrew on August 24, 1992.

Mr. Tate is also an owner and Managing Partner of the Villa del Ray Golf Club, an 18 hole championship golf course located in Delray Beach, Florida and owns and manages a number of commercial properties throughout the South Florida area.
